## VIDEO VISITATION RULES (ON-SITE)

ON-SITE SCHEDULE  
TUESDAY and THURSDAY  
9:00 AM – 4:00 PM

1. On-Site or "free" jail video visits may be scheduled at the jail, by calling the jail, or in advance through the Securus Video Visitation Website, <http://videovisitation.securustech.net/onsite>.
2. Visits must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. Visits are scheduled at the top/bottom of the hour only (ie 9:00am, 9:30am).
3. The visitor must be at least 18 years of age or accompanied by a parent or guardian and present a valid, government issued photo identification during the registration process. Approval can be on-line or at the jail and are generally made within 24 hours, excluding holidays and weekends.
4. The duration of each on-site visit is 25 minutes. Each inmate is allowed one (1) free visit per week.
5. No more than two (2) registered visitors may be present for each visit. Each booth is equipped with 2 handsets.
6. Every visitor must show up at least 5 minutes prior to and no more than 30 minutes before the scheduled visit. Visitors arriving late will only receive the balance of the remaining time or may not be allowed to visit at the discretion of jail staff.
7. All visits, except professional, are recorded and monitored by the Barron County Jail.
8. No NUDITY, provocative clothing, or tight fitting clothing will be allowed during the visit. Violators will be barred from both on-site and off-site visitation for a period of time determined by the Jail.
9. Visitors are required to remain in the visitation booth at all times. Visits may be terminated if the visitor leaves the booth for any reason. Children are not permitted to leave the visitation booth or roam freely outside the booth.
10. Visitors appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, displaying items considered contraband such as drugs, drug paraphernalia, weapons, or displaying gang signs, symbols, colored, ect. are subject to having the visit cancelled and are barred from future visits.
11. Visitors 17 years of age and under must have a parent or guardian present during the on-site visit.
12. Any type of disruptive behavior such as loud talk, shouting, and use of profanity is not permitted.
13. Visitor may only bring their identification and car keys into the visitation area. Cell phones, cameras, or other electronic devices are prohibited. Food and drink (other than water) is prohibited in the booth.
14. Damaging or defacing equipment by inmates or visitors is prohibited and may result in arrest and prosecution.
15. If you are experiencing a problem with the audio or video reception during the visit, please contact the visitation staff immediately.
16. Inmate Workers will not be able to leave their assigned work areas in the jail. It will be the responsibility of the inmate worker to know his/her schedule and report that to visitors.
17. Inmates participating in jail programming such as church service, a meeting with their attorney, and other professional practitioners will not be allowed to leave their assigned area. Inmates should let visitors know the programming schedule to avoid conflicts.
18. Videotaping of any visitation is prohibited.

The Barron County Jail reserves the right to deny, cancel or terminate a video visit prior to or during a video session are based upon visitor or resident inmate misconduct. The Barron County Jail also reserves the right to restrict a visitor from participating in all future use of the system.
